NSQG GUILD SHOW

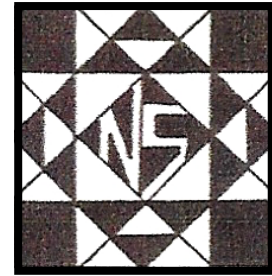
